Notes:

Today I spoke with Mary Broderson regarding the application to be licensed as a Commercial Breeder with IDALS. She asked what the requirement to be a CB was and I explained that if she owned or harbored 4 or more sexually intact adults and was breeding and selling (or advertising such) puppies, then she requires to be licensed prior to operating. She said that she owns 35 AKC Champion cocker spaniels and currently has a litter of puppies that are 4 weeks old. She agreed that the licensing requirement applies to her. I asked her to describe her kennel and she explained the following:

The housing structure is a 50' x 80' shop that Mary said "was set up exactly how I wanted it". The dogs are housed in individual 2' x 4' raised metal kennels with pans below the cages. They are watered with rabbit water bottles and fed in stainless steel food bowls. The exercise pen is a 10' x 20' outdoor covered run with steel panels and a sealed concrete floor. She will rotate dogs thru in groups of 4 or 5 at least twice per day. The run is cleaned with dishsoap and a degreaser after the morning rotation. During inclement weather, a portable play pen is set up in the shop on a section of sealed concrete and she rotates dogs thru this area in a similar manner. Her isolation consists of portable or permanent kennels that are located in her toy hauler RV, which is parked inside the shop. This is also the vehicle that she takes to AKC shows and reports that her sister cares for the dogs while she is away at dog shows or sometimes she will load extra kennels in the toy hauler and take all dogs with her. She believes that she is ready for inspection at this location and reports that AKC inspected her about one year ago when she lived in town (Kiron, IA) and had approximately 12 dogs. We discussed vaccination requirements and she reports that some of her dogs are not vaccinated against rabies. We also discussed the proper way to document the distemper / parvo vaccinations that she administers herself and that records were to be available for inspection for each dog. We also discussed the proper way to keep her sale records. She reports that she keeps AKC litter records and provides a health certificate for each puppy/dog sold and keeps a copy of these documents in her records. We discussed the requirement for a completed VIF by inspection time and a form was e-mailed to her. Her attending veterinarian is Dr Doyle Slavik at Boyer Valley Veterinary Service in Schleswig, IA.
